02 eBay and local online selling pages

Online sales are an easy way for buyers and sellers to support their favourite charities including Hospice.

Whether you're selling through eBay, a local Facebook page, or JT Insight why not commit to donating a percentage from any sale to Hospice- and let your buyers know that they're helping you to support a great cause.

You can then transfer the payment to Hospice via www.jerseyhospicecare.com/donate and select "online sale donation".

When you go to sell something online through eBay look for "Donate a portion to charity" when you list your item. Then select Jersey Hospice Care and pick your donation percentage before finalising your listing. After the buyer has paid, eBay's partners at PayPal Giving Fund will automatically send the donation to Hospice and send you a donation receipt.



Did you know you can raise money for free for Hospice every time you shop online – at no extra cost to you?

Just start your online shopping first at easyfundraising, then shop as normal. Their 4000+ retail partner retailers will then make a small donation to say "thank you".

Get set up in three easy steps:

- O Register online for free at www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/jhc/
- O Every time you shop online, head to Easyfundraising first.
- O Pick the retailer you want to buy from and start shopping as normal

After you've checked out, that retailer will make a free donation to Hospice – it doesn't cost you a penny extra!
