HOW WILL THE SPECIALIST PALLIATIVE CARE TEAM HELP?

Our team of specialist doctors and nurses have extensive knowledge and skills in caring for people with life limiting illnesses. We will focus on supporting you and those close to you by providing advice and support for physical, psychosocial, spiritual or social issues to improve your quality of life.

We will do this by:

- Assessing any symptoms that are troublesome and making suggestions of how these can be improved.
- Listening to your concerns about your illness and those of your family/carer.
- Giving you the opportunity to discuss your treatment, care, and what is important to you.
- Liaising with other health care professionals and teams involved in your care.
